



Please Note

A Transfer Certificate will be issued ONLY WHEN all dues are paid and Transfer Certificate Fees have been paid. Transfer Certificate Charge: ₹100.00 (one hundred) only.

The Report Card must be preserved carefully. In case it is torn / mutilated / defaced, a duplicate Report Card will be issued. Charge for Duplicate Report Card ₹50.00 (fifty) only.
