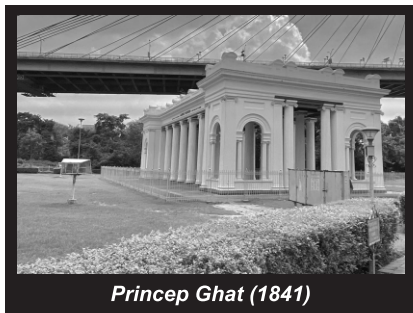

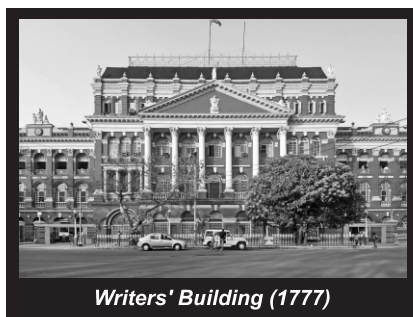

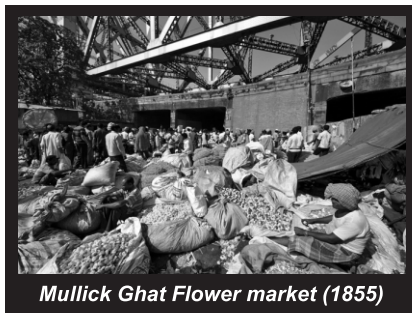

Please Note

The four Houses of the School are: Fire, Air, Water and Earth. Each of the four houses has been divided in three divisions, viz., Junior (classes 1 - 3); Intermediate (classes 4 - 6); Senior (classes 7 - 12).

Payment of Fees: Parents are advised to follow the rules and regulations for payment, as available from the school office and any amendment as communicated to them from time to time in this regard by the Principal. **Fees up to the months of September and March must be paid before the commencement of the Half Yearly and Annual Examinations respectively, failing which the child will not be allowed to sit for the respective examination(s).**

Withdrawals: A notice of TWO calendar months must be given in writing before the withdrawal of a child or fees for TWO months are to be paid in lieu thereof. A Transfer Certificate will be issued **ONLY WHEN** all dues are paid and Transfer Certificate Fees have been paid. Transfer Certificate Charge: ₹100.00 (one hundred) only.

The Report Card must be preserved carefully. In case it is torn / mutilated / defaced, a duplicate Report Card will be issued. Charge for Duplicate Report Card: ₹50.00 (fifty) only.
